


## BACKGROUND TIP.DE

### Germany:

- 1,6 Million people with dementia now
- 3,0 Million people with dementia in 2050
- Necessity to adjust nursing care in nursing homes to:
  - residents with high age and multiple morbidities
  - Individual needs of residents
  - High shortage of manpower in nursing

## RESEARCH QUESTION TIP.DE

Which effects do **theatrepedagogical interventions** have on **quality of life** of people with dementia in nursing homes?

## STUDY DESIGN TIP.DE

### Intervention study

- Two intervention cycles in spring and autumn 2018 in two nursing homes
- Ten weeks with ten theatre intervention hours (one hour per week)
- Up to ten nursing home residents in each intervention group (n=40)
- Assistance by specialised nursing home staff in care for people with dementia



## STUDY DESIGN TIP.DE

### Residents

- Diagnosed dementia (exclusive Korsakow-Syndrome)
  - Nursing care diagnoses (European Nursing Care Diagnosis)
  - Mobile by foot, walking frame, wheelchair
  - Minimum age: 65 years
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- Informed consent from residents and legal guardians


# OUTCOME MEASURES TIP.DE

- Mixed-methods-Design
- Pre-Post comparison

Instrument	Outcome
Mini-Mental State Examination (MMSE) (Folstein, Folstein & McHugh, 1975)	Cognitive impairment
QUALIDEM 2.0 (Dichter et al., 2016)	Quality of life in daily living
Cohen-Mansfield Agitation Inventory (CMAI) (Finkel, Lyons & Anderson, 1992)	Agitation
Heidelberger Instrument zur Lebensqualität Demenzkranker, emotional Scale (HILDE) (Becker et al., 2005)	Emotional reactions in theatre interventions

CMAI – Cohen-Mansfield Agitation Inventory


HILDE – Emotionale Skala HILDE

MMST – Mini Mental-Status-Test

# THEATRE PEDAGOGICAL METHODS TIP.DE

## FIRST STUDY RESULTS TIP.DE

- 30 residents, 80% female, average age 85,02 years, Drop-Out 10%
- Theatre pedagogy has a slight positive effect on cognitive impairment during intervention cycles
- Agitation in daily living can be reduced during intervention cycles
- Relationships between residents and nursing home staff gets positively affected

## FUTURE PROSPECTS TIP.DE

- Publication of the theatre pedagogy concept for easy implementation in nursing homes
- Employment of theatre pedagogues in nursing homes
- Positive effects on nursing situation, communication, work experience
- Second project to specialise the concept for different degrees of dementia and different nursing care settings
